Our materials

Choosing materials and fibres that have a minimal impact on the environment is the foundation of everything that we do at Movesgood. There is no question that bamboo and linen-based fabrics are the most environmentally friendly, making up the core of all of our garments. We also focus our innovation on using and finding the most responsible technologies available for our production process.



The fashion industry is considered to be one of the most pollutive industries in the world, with total greenhouse gas emissions from global textile production of 1.2 billion tons per year. The overuse of cotton and synthetic fibres and the demand for fast fashion is putting further pressure on our planets resources, with chemical-heavy production processes, leaving polluted water and non-recyclable waster behind.



The negative environmental impact occurs across several stages of a product's lifecycle – from materials, sourcing and production, to transport, consumer use and end of life. At Movesgood, we are bringing our sustainability approach to all these stages. One of our commitments, which lies at the core of our business and our garments, is to not use any cotton or synthetic fibres. Instead, we use natural lyocell processed bamboo – one of the most eco-friendly fabrics on the planet.







Linen has a phenomenal absorbency, feels cool and comfortable against the skin and is an incredibly durable fabric- not just for summer. Linen yarn is made from the fibers of the flax plant, which requires minimal irrigation and can be grown without the need for pesticides or artificial fertilisers. In fact, it is one of the most biodegradable fabrics. The plant itself is also extremely versatile and can help clean contaminated soil from heavy metals. It is superb material that we use in many of our garments, mixed with our lyocell processed bamboo, to make it even more soft and durable.








Cashmere is luxuriously soft and warm to wear, but the production puts a lot of pressure on the planet and, as with many natural fibres, it pills very easily. With concerns around the sourcing of virgin cashmere fibres, we only use GRS certified recycled cashmere in our garments. We also blend the cashmere with our unique lyocell processed bamboo. In this way, garments last longer, pill less, are more environmentally friendly and the fabric becomes even more soft!






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Slow Fashion is an awareness and approach of fashion which advocates for quality over quantity, in both product and production. It means investing in a wardrobe of classic, longasting and sustainably produced clothes with a minimal environmental impact. We produce two collections per year, presenting our avourite basic wardrobe items, adapted to the season and current trends. We have a close communication with our customers and work to incorporate their feedback in our designs. We believe in creating season-based fashion made from natural materials with a contemporary design that can be used year after year.

We have developed our own, unique production model that we call Lean Production which is central to our strict sustainability policy. We use only a few, select materials purchased in large volumes, and rely solely on transport by train and boat to minimise our environmental footprint. As a result, we are able to maintain a relatively low price point in relation to the high-quality materials we use and importantly – are as close to climate neutral as possible. Currently, 70% of our production is based in Europe, but we are actively moving towards our goal of having all of our production based in Europe by 2022, further reducing our carbon footprint. We invest significant time in finding the best factories and partners to work with who offer good working conditions, deliver to our standards and follow our Code of Conduct which sets out internationally recognised principles for the protection of human and worker's rights.



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
