A return to slow crafts and the art of making appealing to women who value longevity in an increasingly fast-paced world.

One-of-a-kind jackets made from upcycled blankets hand stitched by artisans, as well as duvet-soft prairie quilted waistcoats offers a casual comforting outer layer. Contrasted with more modest details such as high necks and folklore inspired dresses and tops with exaggerated collars, girly ruffles and fluid volumes all made in beautiful, reused saris.

This Spring - Summer collection of upcycling saris, organic fabrics and "blanket-wear" contribute to a positive change from a culture of waste to one of value.

This High Summer 21 collection evolves around new femininity aesthetics that embrace the overt rather than the demure. Pretty-feminine oversized sleeves, giant ruffles and full volume creating romantic instant statement dresses in both mini, midi and full lengths. GOTS certified double gauze with a super soft touch, turned into one-off tie dye garments for effortless summer styling.

With a drop-the-sparkle approach and a focus on upcycled fabrics this collection consists of eye catching minimal-waste designs created with as little impact on the environment as possible.

This season we treasure even more all the little details and stories told in each pre-worn sari; A hand stitched repair turned into embellishment for a long time keep. This beautifully highlights the built-in value of love in each creation. Patchwork mix and sari prints add an individualist feel amid a fashion industry of mass and more.













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Block Print

Block print is a traditional craft technique from India. Wooden blocks are being carved by hand and used as stamps. The blocks made from woods such as teak, sycamore and pear are lovingly hand-carved in a myriad of intricate designs. Post this, they are soaked in oil for 10-15 days to soften the timber. Once the blocks are ready, they are dipped in color and pressed on to the fabric. This process is repeated until the length of the fabric is complete. Precision is demanded by artisans to ensure a perfect finish.

There are no machines involved only human hands, that creates tiny variations and imperfections that is so charming and unique to this process. In an era when everything is dominated by machineries - and mass production is widespread, this eco friendly handicraft triumphs mill-made garments.

For India, block printing holds a place of pride. Block printing is known to have been used in India since at least the 12th century and this old-age craft has been perfected over generations, and each print is symbolic of the country's vast heritage and rich culture.





With the Indian sari as the foundation of everything we do, we put great value in up-cycling and reusing this traditional garment.

Zero Waste


As a sustainable brand we always work with different solutions to limit waste. Our Zero Waste concept has the goal to use the entire vintage sari we up-cycle for our garments, thus we use the leftover cuttings of fabric for our small items such as hairbands, belts and scarfs.

In our SS21 & HS21 collection as well as our previous collections, the Zero Waste concept includes our signature kimonos. Our kimonos are usually made from one sari, but a big selection of saris have errors or holes which means they do not offer enough fabric for a whole style but only smaller cuttings.

This way any sari with errors can be used for our designs and we continue to limit waste for a more sustainable fashion production.





Tie Dye

The iconic dying technique often associated with hippie image of the 1960s, a symbol of rebellion and psychedelia that has been at the core of several cultural and fashion movements from rock and roll to grunge and new wave is yet again in focus. The technique though, was relevant long before the 20th century. It has been extensively practiced in countries like India for centuries.

Tie Dye also called "Bandhani" comes from the Sanskrit word "banda" which means "to tie". It is a traditional hand dying method where the fabric is tied very tightly at certain points and then dyed. The tied part retains its original color and the final output is a spread of charismatic patterns and whirls. The modernity lies within the design and construction of the tie dye capsule collection, always added the element of India.

Organic Cotton

Our Tie Dye capsule collection is made from GOTS certified organic cotton in an amazing double gauze weave that feels incredible soft on the skin.

The Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS) is recognized as the world's leading processing standard for textiles made from organic fibers. It defines high-level environmental criteria along the entire organic textiles supply chain, including ecological and social criteria, backed up by independent certification of the entire textile supply chain.

The aim of the GOTS certification is to define world-wide recognized requirements that ensure organic status of textiles. It begins in harvesting of the raw materials, through environmentally and socially responsible manufacturing up to labelling in order to provide a credible assurance to the end consumer.


