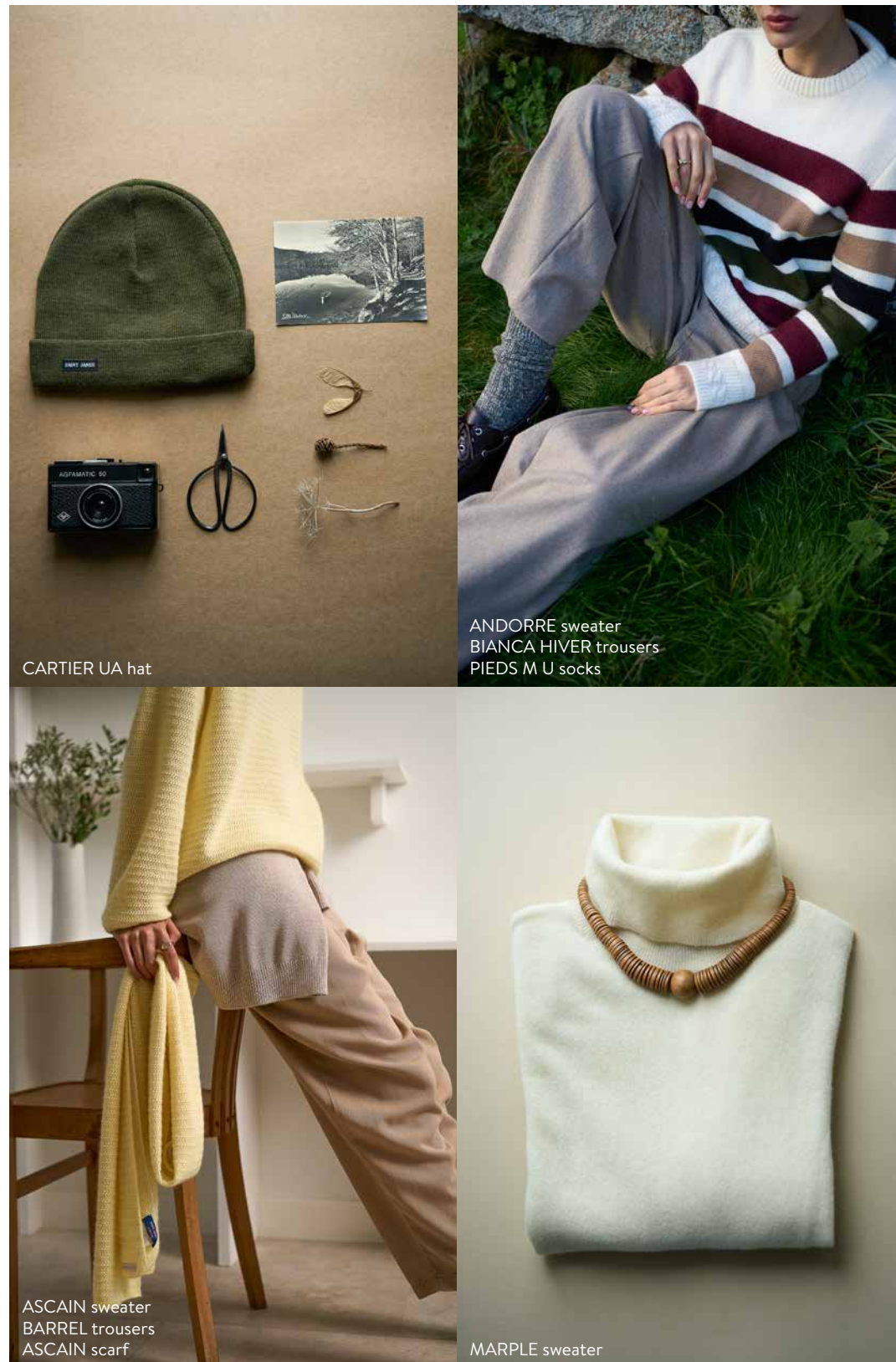

The FW26 collection opens with a smooth transition between late summer and early fall, like a bridge between one season and another. “Knitwear at sea” sets the scene with luminous silhouettes, rooted in a refined coastal universe. From the start of the season, knitwear stands out, between exterior and interior, as the strong signature of the season: the expression of Saint James' historical expertise.

In the heart of winter, the collection asserts its character. Inspired by the authenticity of the Highlands, this second theme features dense, textured knitwear, designed as characterful, protective and durable pieces, set against a natural backdrop with a raw character.

With the “Winter Lights” theme, the collection unfolds in the depths of winter. This third theme of the season celebrates the interior as a contemporary refuge, where light reveals the clean lines and nobility of the materials.
